Dear Friends,

We warmly welcome you to a Youth Section gathering of Members of the School for Spiritual Science under 40 years old from the 26th until the 30th of August 2026 in Dornach, Switzerland.

The aim of the gathering is two fold: a working “in” the school through exploring the 19 lessons as an esoteric schooling (with a youthful pedagogical approach), and working “on” the School by unfolding new possibilities for the presentation and organization of the School of Spiritual Science itself.

The program will take up these aims through exploring the meditative and foundational content of the School of Spiritual Science with Peter Selg, Martina Maria Sam, Nathaniel Williams, and Oliver Conradt through a Class Reading, Free-Rendering and Free-Group Rendering. Hands-on in-studio artistic work will be guided in painting by Esther Gerster, in Sculpture with Ulrikke Stockholm, and on coloured glass with Bernadette Golmer-Hollenstein. In addition, through conversation groups and initiative sessions we will take up the task of finding future ways and forms for the future of the School.

We are hoping to form relationship and substance with those who will carry the School of Spiritual Science into the future age.

What is the School of Spiritual Science?

The School of Spiritual Science is to herald a new age of human consciousness and thus human society. The aims of the School are realized by the work of the Sections (or departments). Each Section is involved in bringing the experiences and capacities developed in esoteric schooling into the world.

The School of Spiritual Science is composed of three Classes: the First, Second, and Third. The First Class focuses on the meditative path of self-knowledge, the Second on the social realm, and the Third on the sacramental realm. However, Rudolf Steiner only gave the nineteen Class Lessons and seven September (or recapitulation) Lessons to members of the School of Spiritual Science, founded at the Christmas Foundation Meeting of 1923/24 (together with the renewed Anthroposophical Society) before becoming ill and dying in 1925.

Becoming a Member

Those who wish to support Anthroposophy and its work in the world may become members of the General Anthroposophical Society. And those who wish not only to support, but also to represent Anthroposophy in the world, may join the School of Spiritual Science.

We feel it is important to understand that membership in the School of Spiritual Science is not simply about gaining access to the Class Lessons, but being a representative of Anthroposophy in the world.
