This seminar is dedicated to encounters in life and meditation. Much of what ails cultural life can be traced to a mode of knowing that only seeks *information* or *data* and not encounters with real *beings*. But people are having — and have always had — encounters that our predominant way of knowing cannot account for. Spiritual and cultural renewal is connected to a transformation in *research*, uncovering meditation and spirit-permeated natural observation as a source of higher understanding and insight. Encounters, a common method in conventional research in the social sciences, offers potential transformative understanding in every field through meditation. The gathering will include presentations, time for individual practice and opportunities for discussion. This is an introductory seminar, and no prior knowledge or experience is necessary. 15 participants can be accommodated.
