



# **The Future of the Anthroposophical Society Towards transformation - strengthening anthroposophy**

## **A members' conference from 12 to 14 December 2025**

How can anthroposophy gain strength and efficacy for its tasks? The committee for the constitutional renewal of the General Anthroposophical Society (Konvent) has developed initial guidelines and invites all Members to a joint consultation on its preliminary findings.

### **The work of the Constitution Committee**

Since its appointment by the 2025 Annual General Meeting, the Constitution Committee has been meeting regularly. Its central question is what kind of Society we need today and in the near future to foster a living anthroposophy with the School of Spiritual Science at its centre, for a world facing the challenges of the twenty-first century. Looking from various perspectives we have developed future images, but new challenges also arise a hundred years after Rudolf Steiner's active work and initiatives.

- We have evolved into a cosmopolitan society with members on all continents. How can we achieve real exchange and a sense of being connected?
- The anthroposophical movement is vibrant and has grown with schools, farms, hospitals and numerous other initiatives existing around the world. What bridges can we build to achieve a stronger connection within the anthroposophical Society and movement?
- How can there be worldwide support for member groups that take on initiatives and assume responsibility?
- What can the spaces for inner and social encounters and activities in our Society look like to make them also attractive for the younger generation?

## **Active involvement of members**

The Constitution Committee has considered the messages received from members and the ideas arising from the four previous constitution conferences in its work. In December we want to continue our direct exchange with the members, working towards a concrete proposal for the Statutes to be submitted to the 2026 Annual General Meeting.

We hope that the conference will provide valuable resonance as well as ideas for a balanced renewal proposal. Please use our Members' platform to submit your suggestions:

The December conference is an important step on our joint path. Based on the results of the conference consultation, the Constitution Committee will work out a concrete proposal for the Statutes that will be submitted to the 2026 AGM.

This proposal can afterwards be calmly discussed in all the groups and branches of the global Society. We hope that the new statutes can then be decided on in 2027 based on a solid foundation that is rooted in our hearts. It is our wish that the intended renewal will embrace, transform and perpetuate the impulse of the Christmas Conference of 1923/1924 from today's perspective.

We look forward to your contributions and to our journey together.
