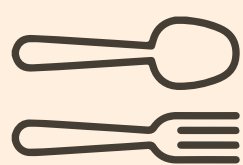


Ticket prices range between **CHF 130 - CHF 350**

The initiative for this congress is supported by the representatives of the various national societies who speak a Latin-Romance language and is highly valued at the Goetheanum as an important impulse in the field of the Anthroposophical Society. The organisation and planning of the conference is supported and realised by members of the General Anthroposophical Section. After two events on peace (2018) and human dignity (2021), this time (2025) the focus will be on Rudolf Steiner himself and the many new doors he opened in such important areas of human culture through the fruits of his spiritual science.



In 2025 it will be 100 years since Rudolf Steiner's death and, like many of our friends around the world, we would like to pause with our Alma Humana conference and reflect with gratitude and dignity on the importance of his legacy for humanity.

We thought we would do this in such a way that we would be able to look at him and Anthroposophy as if through different coloured glasses, based on our current experiences of personal encounters with him. This will be discussed in short contributions while in longer lectures we would like to look directly at his life and his actual legacy, with an awareness of his universality and cosmopolitan future.

For all the people who will come from the different countries, we want to share important and formative experiences through eurythmy and other arts, as they are cultivated at the Goetheanum, which move and stimulate the inner life.

The various working groups will be as diverse and numerous as possible, representing the Latin/Romance languages and countries with their areas of interest.

We cordially invite you and would be delighted if this conference opened the doors of the Goetheanum to many people!
